The tentative schedule shown below will continue until the post-election day canvass is complete and all eligible votes are counted.

START DATES:

- **Logic and Accuracy Testing:** Begins Tuesday, February 25
 - Continue Thursday, February 27
- **Signature Checking & Verification:** Begins Thursday, March 13
- **Ballot Duplication:** Begins Monday, March 17
- **Reconciliation:** Begins Monday, March 17
- **Open, Extraction, & Quality Assurance:** Begins Monday, March 17
- **Ballot Scanning:** Begins Friday, March 28
- **Ballot Adjudication:** Begins Tuesday, April 1
- **Provisional Ballot Processing:** Begins Monday, April 14 (post-election)

- Random Draw begins Thursday, April 10 at 10 a.m.
- Manual tally begins Tuesday, April 15 at 9 a.m.
 - The Manual Tally will then continue each day, until completed, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Manual Tally hours may be extended, including evenings until 8 p.m. and/or on weekends and holidays.

ELECTION RESULTS POSTING SCHEDULE

- After 8 p.m., Tuesday, April 8 (following the close of vote centers, periodic result updates will continue throughout the night until all vote center ballots are reported).
- After election night, the next unofficial results update will be posted on the following schedule:
 - By 6 p.m., Thursday, April 10, Friday, April 11, and Monday, April 14
 - Additional updates will occur at the discretion of the Registrar of Voters with the date of the next posting prominently displayed on the unofficial results bulletin.

All results are unofficial until completion of the official canvass of the election on or before May 8.

Please note the office will be closed on March 31 in observance of Cesar Chavez Day.
