California Gubernatorial Recall Election SEPTEMBER 14, 2021

Every active registered voter in San Diego County will receive a ballot in the mail for the upcoming election. If you want to vote in this election you must be registered to vote. It takes less than two minutes to register to vote online at sdvote.com.

WHAT IS A RECALL ELECTION?

California is one of 19 states that allows any elected official to be "recalled" (removed from office). For the first time in nearly 20 years, California will hold an election that asks voters if they want to remove the governor from office.

The ballot will ask two questions:

- 1) Do you want to recall the governor from office?
- 2) If recalled, who do you want to replace him?

Sign, seal, and return your ballot to a trusted source:



U.S. Postal Service

Your mail ballot must be postmarked by Election Day and received by our office no later than Sept. 21. No postage required.



Mail ballot drop-off location (MBDO)

Return your ballot at one of over 130 mail ballot drop-off locations around the county. If dropping off, your ballot must be received by 8 p.m. Election Night, Sept. 14.

Take advantage of early voting at the Registrar's office located in Kearny Mesa at 5600 Overland Ave., beginning August 16, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday - Friday



In-person voting locations and the Registrar's office from Sept. 11 - 14

Voting locations will be open:

- Saturday, Sept. 11 - Monday, Sept. 13, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Election Day, Tuesday, Sept. 14, from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
